### The project: short & long terms

### Accommodation and meals

Volunteers will live in a shared house with other international participants. Rooms will be shared for volunteer groups and long-term ESC volunteers will either have an individual room or a room shared with one other participant.

Volunteers will receive a weekly food allowance as well as a general kitty to be able to buy food and household necessities either

individually or as a group.

The accommodation is well located; 5 minutes' walk from a local beach and with all the appliances and equipment needed for self-catering and learning to cook the local food. There are 2 shared cars and 2 bikes which can be used by volunteers.

Pos Chiquito where trainees live is a local community towards the south of the island, serviced with a supermarket, laundrette, snack-van and DIY stores for household necessities. There is a lovely beach just over 5 minutes' walk, a local beach bar (frequented by locals not tourists) and three restaurants in walking distance.

The main tourist attractions are in the North of the island around Palm Beach and Noord where there is also a large supermarket (Superfoods) worth the drive for a large weekly shop.
