



## Donkey Sanctuary Aruba

### The project

The Donkey Sanctuary in Aruba takes care of 130 donkeys. As part of their project, volunteers will help with the sanctuary husbandry routine: Provide donkeys with food and water, carry out health checks and clean/ maintain the area. You will also assist vet visiting sanctuary, and have the opportunity to work in the shop and deal with visitors and their visit.

Volunteers can spend time in a local vet surgery observing and supporting the veterinary staff. You could also take part in a dog grooming project.

Depending on the season of the activity trainees may have chance to be involved with turtle conservation work or bat monitoring in the national park.

### Accommodation and meals

Volunteers will live in a shared house with other international participants. Rooms will be shared two volunteers per room. You are responsible for the accommodation which will be checked on a monthly basis.

Volunteers will receive pocket money and a food allowance paid into their bank account monthly.

The accommodation is well located, 5 minutes walk from a local beach and with all the appliances and equipment needed for self catering and learning to cook the local food.

There is a car and bikes which can be used by Tur Cos Ta Posibel volunteers.

- Be happy to work outside
- Be flexible to try different activities
- Be sociable like meeting people
